

Awarded Grants

Greater Kansas City Community Foundation COVID 19 Relief

Funds from the Kansas City Regional COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund will help supplement the loss of funding from cancelling fundraising events. With these response and recovery funds, the district will continue to provide the following services for students and their families during this difficult time through the Assisted Transportation program: curbside meals to families, student medicine pick up and distribution, curriculum and instruction, and early childhood education services. The district also provides housing support in the form of rent, mortgage and utilities to the vulnerable families in the district that are financially struggling, displaced or already homeless. Funds from the Kansas City Regional COVID-19 Response and Recovery Fund will allow KCKSFFE to continue to provide these services to the students and their families with critical needs in the district.

CARES Act Funding

This grant is for essential support to keep students and their families well informed during the pandemic. Funds will be used to facilitate internet access for students and their families, provide guidance about protocols and share information they can use as a resource for getting support. Funds will also be used to pay for software and web support to continue to share information online.

What is Happening with the Foundation?

With school closures due to COVID 19, Pizza Hut reached out to see if they could assist with the district's meal services efforts by supplying free pizzas for students.

The Kansas City, Kansas School Foundation for Excellence (KCKSFE) shared the generous idea with district officials and decided that it would be more beneficial to serve graduating seniors at each high school when they picked up their diplomas. Pizza Hut donated 850 pizzas, and the KCKSFE covered the cost for the remaining students. The Foundation partnered with Sharita Hutton, Director of the Communications and Marketing Department, and the high school principals to make this exciting opportunity happen!

During this difficult time, our teachers, staff and community partners are going to great lengths to ensure that our students succeed, and they deserve our recognition and support. Go to


