Vendor Agreement

1. This event is a community **resource** fair. Vendors may share information, but **may not** sell products or services or collect payment on-site.
2. Vendors **must** remain for the entire duration of the event and agree to follow all event guidelines.
3. Event organizers reserve the right to remove vendors not in compliance with this agreement.
4. Vendors **must** remain set up for the entire event (8:00 AM – 1:00 PM).
5. Upon setting up tables and chairs, you agree **not to** change or rearrange the vendor space setup.
6. Attendance occurs in waves; please plan materials accordingly.
7. We recommend not distributing all items during the first hour.
8. Giveaways and swag are strongly encouraged.
9. We recommend planning for 5000 attendees during the event.

We strongly encourage all vendors to **complete setup on Friday Afternoon** to ensure a smooth start on the event day.

Afternoon Before

- **Date:** Friday, July 31st
- **Time:** 2:00 PM - 5:00 PM
- **Location:** HomeField, 9250 State Ave, Kansas City, KS

Instructions

- **Entry Point:** Please enter through the **northwest corner** of the building, located around the back.
- **Check-In:** Upon arrival, check in with our event staff at the designated drop-off area.
- **Table Selection:** Choose your table and drop off your materials. The table is first-come, first-served for the location.

Day of Event

- **Date:** Saturday, August 1st, 2026
- **Time:** Doors open at 6 AM, please arrive no later than 7:15 AM
- **Location:** HomeField, 9250 State Ave, Kansas City, KS

Instructions

- **Entry Point:** Please enter through the **southwest corner** of the building.
- **Check-In:** Register at the check-in table located at the entrance.
- **Setup Completion:** Ensure your booth is **fully set up by 7:30 AM**.
- **Parking:** Follow the signs to the vendor parking area after unloading your materials. **Must have** parking Pass Printed for access to the parking lot. (Map included.)

Food

- No outside food or drink is allowed in HomeField; reusable water bottles are allowed
- **NO FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE MAIN LEVEL!**
- Boxed Lunch will be available for purchase for **vendors** for \$10, plus tax.

- If you do not purchase lunch, you must make your own off-site arrangements, or bring your lunch. You will still be required to sit on the second level or outside to eat, per HomeField policy.

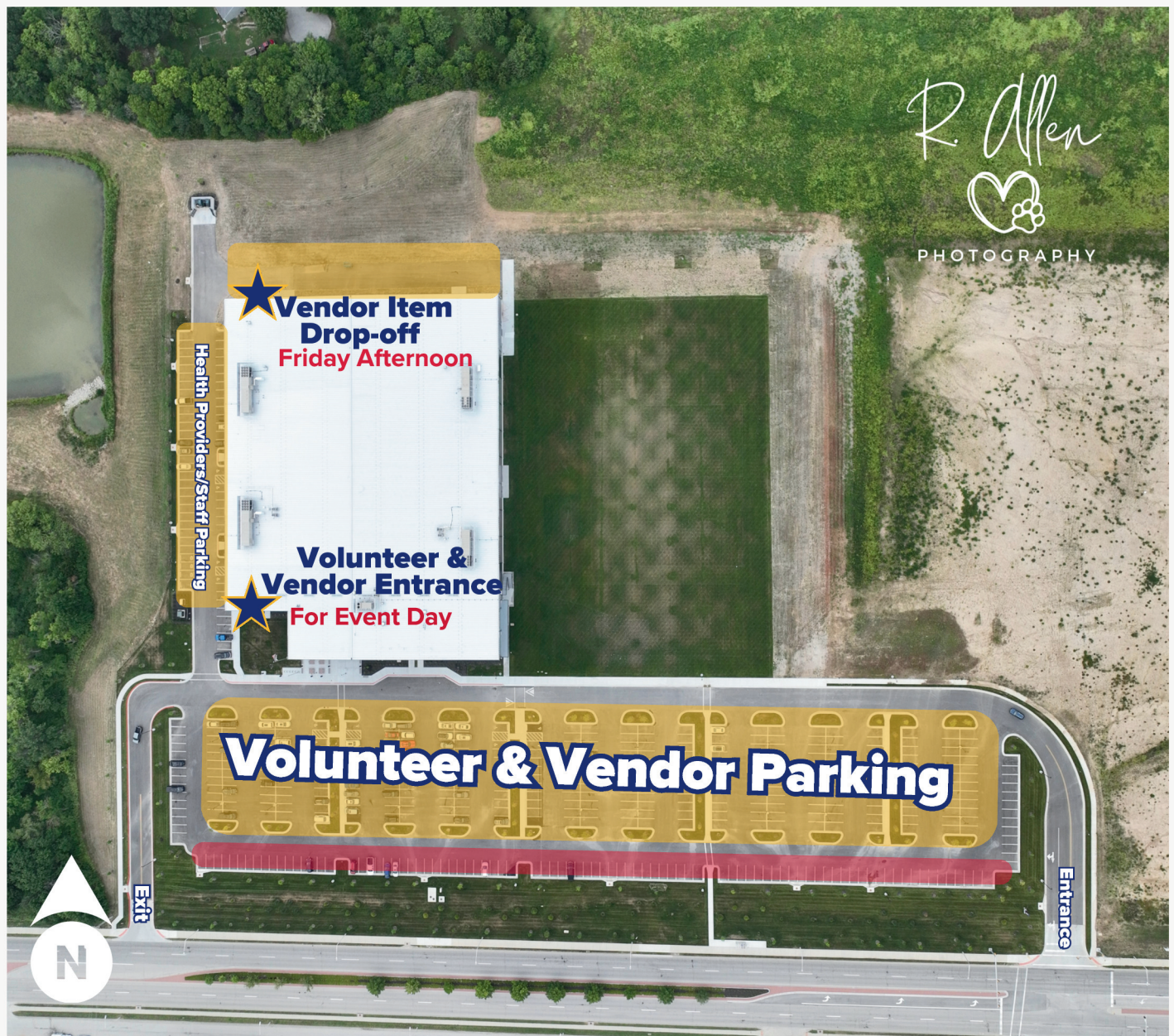
HomeField KCK Policies (No Exceptions):

- No food is allowed on the main level.
- Vendors who purchase lunch must take a break and eat only on the second level.
- Drinks will not be provided. Drinks may be purchased separately with your lunch.
- All attendees may bring a reusable water bottle to be refilled at designated water stations.

These policies are set by the venue and must be followed by all participants to maintain a clean and safe environment.

Parking

- **All Parking is free**
- **Parking Pass:** Please print out a vendor parking pass or pick one up at the check-in table and place it in your car, or you may not be able to park in the front/main lot.
- **Shuttle Service:** **Please avoid parking in the back row (south side)** of the lot to allow easy access for the shuttle to the event parking for our guests, highlighted red in image above.

Additional Notes:

- **Early Arrival:** Please Arrive Early to ensure ample time for any additional setup. The doors open promptly at 8:00 AM, and there is always a line of community members waiting to enter.
- **Signage:** Look for directional signs and staff members who will guide you to the correct locations.
- **Assistance:** If you need help at any point, please do not hesitate to ask our event staff.
