Career-Driven Impact

London, an occupational therapy student, embodies the program's focus on nurturing purpose-driven careers. "I've always been driven by a desire to help others and ensure that everyone has the chance to live a happy, full life," she says. Her scholarship ensures she can prioritize hands-on training over part-time jobs, accelerating her path to serving vulnerable populations.

Financial Relief and Academic Excellence

For Diana, a marketing scholar, the award is both a practical lifeline and a motivator. "Receiving this scholarship is incredibly meaningful."

"This scholarship will help me with tuition and housing at KU, ensuring I can continue in the program," she says. For highachievers like Amia, the foundation's support is a non-negotiable enabler of their accelerated paths. Record-Breaking Year: *KCKPS Scholars Benefit from Unprecedented Scholarship Support*

When 37 KCKPS scholars walked across the stage this May, they carried more than awards—they carried the collective belief of donors like you. Thanks to your unwavering support, the Kansas City, Kansas School Foundation for Excellence shattered records this year, awarding **\$108,000+ in scholarships**—the highest total in our 35-year history. This milestone isn't just a number; it's 37 pathways to degrees, trades, and generational change.

This year, the Kansas City, Kansas School Foundation for Excellence is celebrating a major milestoneawarding over \$100,000 in college scholarships, affirming its ongoing commitment to supporting academic achievement for students in our community.

On Wednesday, April 30, Kansas City, Kansas Public Schools students were honored with scholarships during a special ceremony held at Central Office, recognizing their academic dedication and future potential.

The scholarships range between \$1,000 and \$5,000, allowing KCKPS students to pursue higher education.

To be eligible for scholarships, students must have 2.0 GPA or better, submit a 500-word essay, and

furnish a recommendation letter from a high school counselor, principal, teacher, or community leader. They must also plan to attend the fall semester of 2025 at an accredited college, university, or technical school.

Much of the scholarship funds are generated from our annual golf tournament and annual endowments.
